Science and Technology Academics Reinforcing Basic Aviation and Space Exploration

STARBASE VICTORY currently serves all 4th, 5th and 6th grade students in the Portsmouth Public School system. Our students come aboard for a four or five day hands-on, minds engaged math and science learning experience. "This can't be school, they say... it's too much fun!"



PROGRAM COMPONENTS

- Students wear a T-shirt "uniform" and select their own call-sign to use during their time at STARBASE...in so doing, they become "special".
- Fourth graders learn spatial relationships, mapping and geospatial concepts. They receive a compass to take home.
- Fifth graders learn about climate, weather and the local watershed. Then they make their own video about their experiences.
- Sixth graders learn elementary physics of air and flight. They use a computer flight simulator and build their own rocket... launching it at graduation!
- All classes conduct Virginia Standards of Learning aligned experiments and activities to see how mathematics and science is used in the "real world".
- Self esteem, goal setting and the importance of teamwork are crucial lessons throughout the curriculum.
- An exciting summer program is offered for each of the grade levels.

The Partnership

The STARBASE Victory concept is a unique partnership between the Portsmouth Public School system, the community and a non-profit corporation called STARBASE Victory, Incorporated. Nine specially equipped classrooms, dedicated buses and a laptop computer for every student make the school special. Eleven certified instructors with postgraduate degrees present engaging lessons in simple physics, aeronautics, environmental issues and geospatial relationships. The community (you!) provides the funding. Our non-profit corporation manages the program. We have been serving Portsmouth's students since the spring of 2001.
